NOTICE OF RACE

All times in this notice of race are in Belgian summertime GMT+2 24-hour format.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The prescriptions of the National Authority will not apply.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix T, Arbitration applies.
- 1.3. RRS Appendix P applies.
- 1.4. [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Failure to comply may be misconduct.
- 1.5. RRS 90.3(e) applies with a time limit of 48 hours. This changes RRS 90.3e.
- 1.6. If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The sailing instructions will be available at least 14 days before the start of the event, on the website <https://www.noordlimburgmaas.be/nl/zeilwedstrijden> and www.euregioregatta.com

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The official notice board is located at the window of the clubhouse.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to all boats.
- 4.2. Aim is as many unit classes with regard to the following restrictions

HDP A : Handicap SW < 110

HDP B : Handicap SW >- 110

HDP C : Dynghy's All Handicaps

HDP D / E : A unit class will be added when a minimum of 5 boats of that class participate

- 4.3. Eligible boats may enter at the online registration page. which can be found on the following website www.euregioregatta.com
- 4.4. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees. Any sailor who has not, by the closing time for registration, completed registration at the venue will be removed from the list of sailors for that event and will not be scored at that event. This also applies to sailors who have not complied with all other entry requirements



5. FEES

5.1. Required fees are as follows:

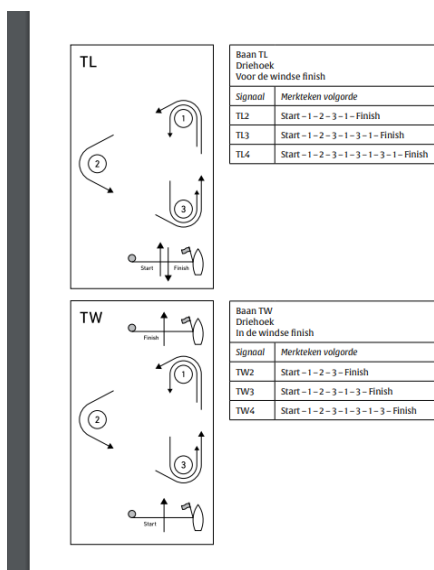
13. THE COURSES

14. SCORING

14.1.3 Valid races are required to validate the championship.

14.2. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

14.3. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15. 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 SPARE

21. DATA PROTECTION AND MEDIA RIGHTS

21.1 By entering this event, you allow the Organizing Authority to display your name, type and sail number of the registered boat on online and printed entry lists, positions during racing, results, articles in press and social media.

21.2 By entering this event, you allow the Organizing Authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live,



taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation

22. RISK STATEMENT

22.1 RRS3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough water, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, hypothermia or other causes.

23. INSURANCE

23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

24. PRIZES

24.1 There will be prizes for the podium places in each class
